



## 2024 CYO GOLF TOUR

The 2024 CYO Golf Tour will include three seasonal tournaments and a qualifying Championship event.

Golfers are welcome to enter any and all seasonal tournaments.

Top 50 net golfers from the Girls & Boys Gold Divisions from each event will qualify for the CYO Championship tournament.

No Navy or C golfers are eligible for the CYO Championship.

Registration fees apply for all four events.

Both Individual and Team awards will be presented at each event.

Winter Golf Tournament – Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup> @ Arcadia 3 Par (Arcadia)

Spring Golf Tournament – Saturday, February 8th @ Arcadia 3 Par (Arcadia)

## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

- **Pre-Event Registration Fee:** \$50 per person – Credit Card payment required. NO REFUNDS. **Please supply CYO one (1) payment for your entire team.** No checks will be accepted.
- **Team Registration:** **Each team will be limited to 15 participants.**
  - Teams can consist of any combination of A, B, and/or C level golfers but must not exceed 15 golfers.
  - Additional spots may be granted upon request after the registration deadline. Priority to 7/8 grade golfers.
  - The limit is due to high demand and to allow more CYO schools to participate.
- **Registration Deadline:** Registration and roster must be received by CYO on or before 12:00pm on **Friday, September 24th, 2024.**
  - This is an ABSOLUTE deadline.
- **Event Registration:** All registrations must be done online. Paid with Credit Card. No Walk-Up Registrations will be accepted. Registration deadline is **September 24th, 2024.**
- **Team Rosters:** After you register, a confirmation Receipt will be emailed to you.
  - AD/Coach must complete Roster form online connected to your registration.

## TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 9 Holes - Stroke Play: Each player must have their own bag, clubs, and equipment.
- 14 club rule will be enforced.
- Max score of 5 on all holes -- all holes are Par 3.
- Two nine-hole courses will be utilized for the Fall Tournament. In an effort to make tournament play more efficient, a more equal amount of players will be placed on the front and back nine courses.
- A & B level golfers will be designated as “Gold” or “Navy”. The “Gold” and “Navy” designations will apply to both boy and girl A & B level golfers.
- A & B “Gold” golfers will play the back nine course.
- The “C” level and A & B “Navy” golfers will play the front nine.
- A & B “Gold” designated golfers will compete for individual trophies and their scores will be used to determine team awards.
- Coaches from each school will need to designate which of their A & B golfers will be considered “Gold” or “Navy”. Only the “Gold” golfers, designated by the coach, will contribute to the team awards.
- Coed Team Competition – top 4 scores from each school count as a team (*from A & B “Gold” level only*). C level and A & B “Navy” golfers are playing a different course they will not be considered for the team score.
- C level will qualify for individual awards/trophies. The lowest scoring A & B “Navy” golfers (boys and girls) will be awarded.
- You may choose to have a C golfer play at the B “Gold” level to qualify for the team award and any potential individual B “Gold” awards. The golfer will not be eligible for any individual C level awards.
- Top individual awards in girls division for A & B “Gold” and C.
  - Award # is subject to change based on number of participants
- Top individual awards in boys division for A & B “Gold” and C.
  - Award # is subject to change based on number of participants
- Each A & B “Gold” level player can compete both individually and as part of a team (if 3 others from the same school register and play the same course).
- Ties broken by card off – scores of each hole, starting at nine and going back, will be compared until winner is found.
- Open to players in grades 2 through 8 who have golf experience. PLEASE NO BEGINNING GOLFERS AS THIS SLOWS THE PACE OF THE TOURNAMENT.
- All 7th and 8th graders will be A level, all 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades will be B level, and all 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> grades will be C level for individual awards.
- For every four registered golfers from a school, that school must provide a volunteer (If you register the max of 12 golfers you must supply 3 volunteers). A volunteer will accompany each A & B level foursome to ensure that a good pace of play is maintained. The volunteer will not be a representative from one of the schools in the foursome. (As an example, if the foursome consist of two golfers from St. James and two from AMS, the volunteer assigned to that foursome will be from Beatitudes.) Volunteers will also be needed to help chaperone the C level golfers. One chaperone per foursome. School responsibilities will be posted on the tee times.
