## Archdiocese of Los Angeles Boundary Guidelines and Code of Conduct for Junior High and High School Youth Working or Volunteering with Children or Youth

To ensure the safety of the children and youth in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, all youth volunteers – junior high and high school students, including students who are already 18 – who work or volunteer with children/youth in school or parish settings must receive training on these Boundary Guidelines before undertaking their ministry in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and must sign this Code of Conduct form to verify they understand their obligations.
